David C. Brisk, a lifelong Waukesha resident with many friends and family in the Glidden area, died at Waukesha Memorial Hospital on Saturday, September 7, 2019 at the age of 79. He was born in Waukesha on August 12, 1940 the son of Clyde W. and Gladys M. (nee Torrison) Brisk. Dave was a member of the first graduating class of Waukesha South High School in 1958. On September 2, 1961 he married Geraldine Bauer. Following high school, he enlisted in The Wisconsin National Guard and went to Fort Leonard Wood for basic training and then to Fort Gordon for Signal School. He was involved in the call up in 1961 for the Berlin Wall Crisis and was stationed at Fort Lewis Washington. He attained the rank of sergeant in the 32nd Red Arrow Division. Dave was a dedicated member of the DJ Martin American Legion Post 8 where he was commander for nine years. He was also past State Vice Commander and District Commander of the American Legion. He also served for over 20 years as a director, on the board of Randle Dable Brisk Funeral Home Inc.

Dave was employed for 37 years in quality control at Wisconsin Centrifugal. He was an avid outdoorsman who enjoyed hunting, fishing, metal detecting, going to his cabin in Glidden, WI; going to his daughter's cabin in the town of Beaver, WI and was a proud member of the National Rifle Association

He was a lifelong member of St. Luke's Lutheran Church where his grandparents were charter members.
